A message from our President Dan Fahrer...

Fall MESSAGE FROM LEPOA President Dan Fahrer

The end of the unofficial summer season (Memorial Day to Labor Day) has come and gone but the calendar season of Summer and early Fall will continue as we look forward to a few more weeks of boating, fishing, and recreation before the harsh reality of winter is upon us. However, our Loch Erin community certainly enjoyed one spectacular Labor Day weather weekend!! I would like to acknowledge and thank the Events Committee for their volunteerism in coordinating all the activities within our park areas that saw great participation from LEPOA residents and their guests. In addition, I would like to recognize both Phil K. and Kathy Z. from our Board for their efforts towards our lake water quality and that our Parks were pristine following the high wind event that occurred ~2 weeks ago. Our lake water and Parks are the cornerstones that allow everyone to enjoy our lake community, and I know we have numerous volunteers that support both Phil and Kathy in their efforts, so THANK YOU to EVERYONE that was involved.

The Board is aware of the concerns that many of you have expressed regarding a proposed boat launch in the planned development on the west end of our Lake. The Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) has a structured process with defined criteria that they will be reviewing as part of the application and review process. As I understand it, quite a few residents adjacent to the development and within the Loch Erin community have already provided feedback to EGLE. In addition, here are a few highlights from our past meetings and a look to the future.

- We continue to gather numerous 'historical records' (paper files) from various sources, after that we will be developing a plan that will be discussed at a future Board meeting. We will need help sorting and purging (where appropriate) and then transferring these paper documents to some form of electronic medium for better access and future reference. This electronic file system will help us better navigate future issues and challenges within LEPOA.
- We have discussed a 'Stakeholder Engagement Plan' where we (LEPOA) need to express our support or concerns to various elected or appointed officials within the local and State regarding issues that may impact our community, such as water quality, zoning/master planning within the Township/County, road and drain commissions...(Stay tuned, as there may be some volunteer opportunities)
- The Board will be developing a proposed 2024 Budget, and the Capital Expenditure
 criteria, scoring and weighting factor tool will be used to prioritize various potential
 projects, so everyone be able to see long range planning efforts, recommendations,
 and decisions made by the Board. We are also moving forward with developing
 scope documents and an issue capture/resolution log to improve our Board
 effectiveness.

So, let us enjoy the Fall season, extended summer, the vibrant colors, fishing, and boating opportunities over the next 6 weeks or so. Stay safe on the water!

FISH STOCKING


